Not every document in the library does the same job. Some frame instruments, some isolate use cases, and some interpret findings for everyday readers. This guide helps visitors understand what they are looking at before they over- or under-read the material.

Document role first

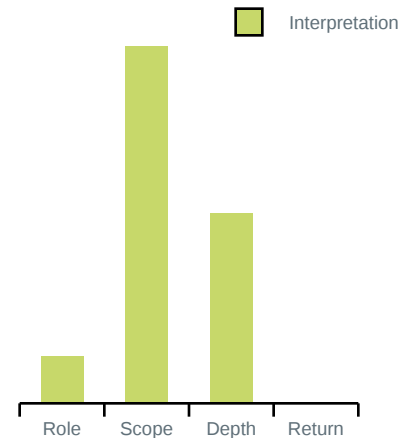
Each note should state whether it is a framework, protocol, reference index, or interpretive summary.

One result is not everything

A single chart or demo should support a question, not stand in for the entire category.

Read with sequence

Begin with summary language, then move into charts, notes, and related documents only as needed.

Key signal across document sections**Closing section**

This guide should sit near the document library so new readers can learn how to move through evidence without getting lost in the archive.
